You are invited to attend a new course for the Accreditation of Probity Service Providers - Procurement, designed specifically to develop and accredit Probity Auditors and Advisers to a standard acceptable to Government and industry in provision of probity services, particularly in areas of procurement of goods equipment property and services. This course also will apply to probity services to grants, sponsorships, funding regimes, competitive bidding arrangements, and consultative processes, particularly related to government.

This new course has been developed in consultation with industry, government, and academia, to provide a level of accreditation for the services of probity auditors and advisers.

Accreditation from this course is expected to be recognised by government as the skills level and standards required of its probity service providers at a National level.

This is a highly practical course program of learning and case studies, aimed at the expectations for delivery of probity services related to procurement and similar processes.

The course is supported by a Textbook and a course Handbook, all included in the course fees. Course presenters include highly experienced individuals in both probity and law, whose expertise is recognised by government and industry.
