James E.(Jim) Box

M.I.Exp.E., MIAMA, J.P.(Qual)

Jim Box is the principal of Room to Run Pty Ltd, providing consulting services in probity, procurement and mediation to the government and private sectors. He was formerly a Chief Executive Officer in industry for 21 years where he worked with sourcing supply inputs to major industrial and government projects; and prior to that was a Lieutenant Colonel in the Australian Army where he was a technology specialist.

Jim is the co-author of the textbook, *'Probity and Managing Procurement: how to avoid corrupting the process'* published by Lexis Nexis Butterworths, and former editor of the supply industry journal, *'Australian Purchasing & Supply'*.
